Thank you for contacting us about HUGGIES® LITTLE SWIMMERS® disposable swimpants. We appreciate the opportunity to provide information about the use of HUGGIES LITTLE SWIMMERS swimpants in pools.

HUGGIES LITTLE SWIMMERS swimpants were developed in response to consumer demand for a diaper-like product that would not deteriorate or swell in pools. According to the National Swimming Pool Foundation, disposable diapers can cause problems when they are used in pools. That is because they swell and burst when saturated, releasing bits of diaper material that can clog costly pool filtration systems. HUGGIES LITTLE SWIMMERS swimpants contain an innovative absorbent material to provide pre-swim protection, but they do not swell up in the water like disposable diapers.

HUGGIES LITTLE SWIMMERS swimpants do provide protection against urine and BM leakage prior to swimming. When used while swimming, HUGGIES LITTLE SWIMMERS help contain solid BM. When the child is in the water, urine, BM and water will mix, as they would with any other type of swimwear.

With regard to bacterial contamination, HUGGIES LITTLE SWIMMERS swimpants do not contain any ingredient which will kill bacteria. We are not aware of any swimming apparel, rubber pants, swimsuits, or diapers which will prevent the spread of bacteria in swimming pools. To prevent the spread of diseases, we suggest that parents do not allow children who are sick or who have diarrhea to use public swimming facilities.
